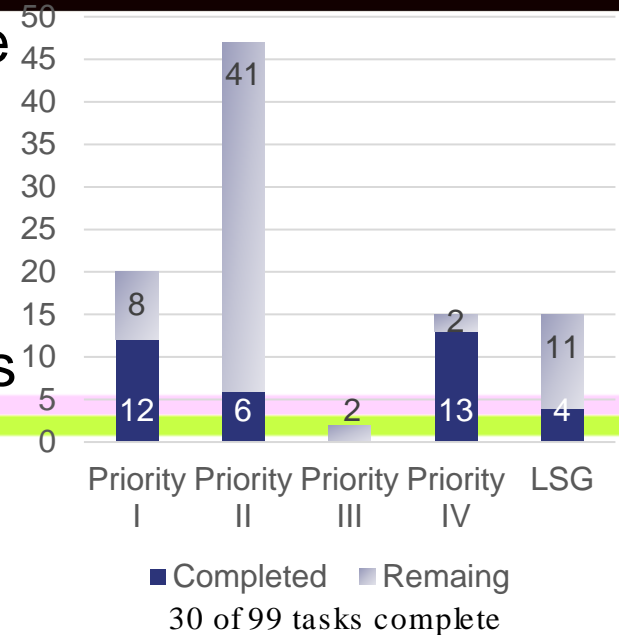

# Multi -Tiered System of Support (MTSS)



TEA and Austin ISD have identified a need for guidance in high quality learning and interventions as part of the Agreed Order:

Universal screening

Tier 1, 2 and 3 interventions

Decision-making protocols using assessments and data indicators

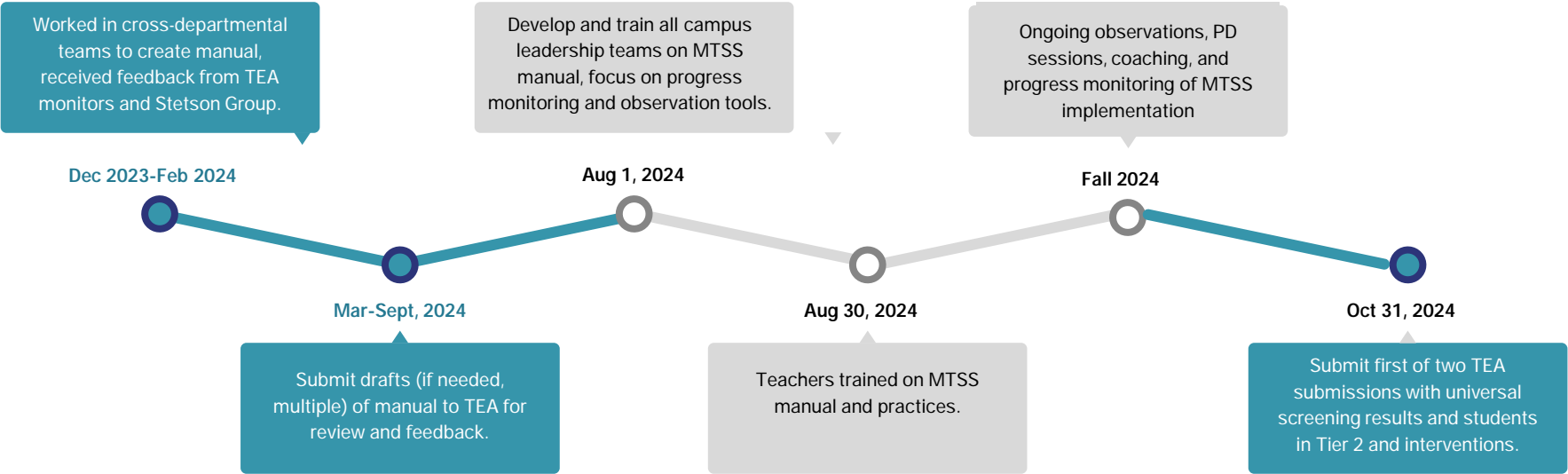
Common, district-wide instructional practices and look-for components in literacy and math

The MTSS Manual will serve as a guiding document and will ground professional learning for campuses to successfully implement MTSS.

All campuses will be trained in MTSS, and the district will monitor and support implementation with observations, PD, coaching, and systems monitoring.

We are changing the MTSS to be driven by *clear guidelines, common tools* across the district, include *clear protocols* for implementation and expectations, clear protocols for *data-based decision making*, and will *codify* this in the form of the MTSS manual so all campuses have access and understanding of how to build and maintain a high quality MTSS for their students.
